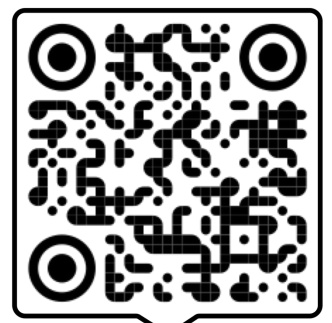
Who: Open to all students (enrolled or not) with an interest in **cross-cultural communication, anthropology and journalism.**
